What is Leadership Central Palm Beach?

The Central Palm Beach County Chamber has been conducting Leadership programs since 2008. It is scheduled to begin the next class in January 2022. This interactive educational program is designed for individuals entering, or already occupying decision-making positions in their company or organization and seeking the opportunity to assume active leadership roles in the community.

Central Palm Beach Leadership is a comprehensive program focusing on key business/public demographics within the coverage area of the Central Chamber – including Public Safety, Medical/Health Services, Arts & Education, Science & Environmental, Agricultural, and Media & Government. The six-month program is designed with the following goals in mind:

- Develop individuals for leadership roles
- Provide in-depth review of community resources and functions
- Develop a mutual understanding between business and community participants
- Motivate participants to become involved in community activities.

Through the interactive educational opportunities of Central Palm Beach Leadership, participants will gain an awareness of resources of the communities served by the Central Palm Beach County Chamber of Commerce, along with an understanding of key issues facing these communities and the business community within. It will unite individuals who see the opportunity and responsibility of assuming active leadership roles.

Pre-paid tuition is \$475.00 for Chamber members and \$625.00 for non-members. This includes meals, transportation, supplies and related expenses
